Power on your display and set it to the correct input Source

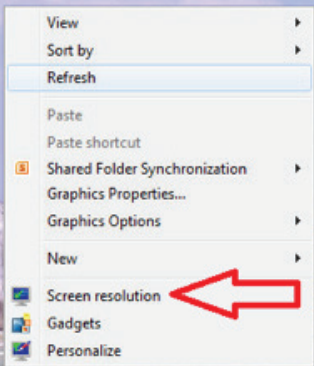

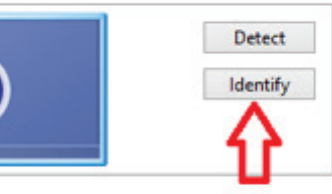

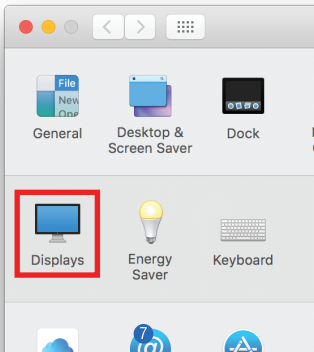

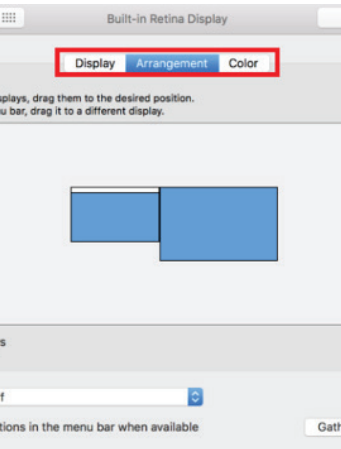
